### **ELEVENTH AMENDED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER**

#### **LIMITED COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

##### **FIRST ADDENDUM**

**June 4, 2021**

##### **PURPOSE AND INTENT**

The purpose and intent of this First Addendum to the Eleventh Amended Notice of Public Health Order is to clarify and harmonize this Pitkin County Public Health Order with all of the State of Colorado and Federal Orders.

##### **ORDER**

This Addendum augments and modifies the terms of the Eleventh Amended Notice of Public Health Order. The terms of this Addendum are effective as of 12:01 A.M. MDT June 4, 2021, within the entirety of Pitkin County, including all municipalities within the County, until further modified or rescinded by future order. Where the terms of this Addendum differ from the Eleventh Standing Public Health Order, the terms of this addendum shall control. Where the terms of this Addendum and the Eleventh Standing Public Health Order differ from any State Public Health Orders or Federal Orders, the more strict shall control. This Addendum adopts the definitions used in the State Public Health Orders and in particular Order 20-38 unless otherwise defined.

#### **1. Incorporation of State Orders**

- a. All Executive Orders issued by the Governor of Colorado and all Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) Public Health Orders are hereby adopted and deemed incorporated herein.

#### **2. Compliance with State Orders**

- a. In order to safely open and operate, businesses and other entities allowed to operate must comply with all Executive Orders issued by the Governor of Colorado as well as all CDPHE Public Health Orders and are encouraged to comply with all State Guidance applicable to such operations.



**3. Incorporation of Federal Orders**

- a. All Orders issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), and all Federal Orders are hereby adopted and deemed incorporated herein.

**4. Compliance with Federal Orders**

- a. In order to safely open and operate, businesses and other entities allowed to operate must comply with all Orders issued by the CDC as well as all Federal Orders and are encouraged to comply with all CDC Guidance applicable to such operations.

**Public Health Agency Authority**

The Pitkin County Public Health Department is tasked with protecting the health and welfare of the residents and visitors of Pitkin County, Colorado by investigating and controlling the causes of epidemic and communicable disease. This Addendum is necessary to control any potential transmission of disease to others. See section 25-1-508, Colorado Revised Statutes. Immediate issuance of this Order is necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, or welfare.

Any person aggrieved and affected by this Order or any action taken by Public Health to enforce the Order has the right to request judicial review by filing an action with the Pitkin County District Court within 90 days of the date of this Order, pursuant to section 25-1-515, Colorado Revised Statutes. However, you must continue to obey the terms of this Order while your request for review is pending.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ADDENDUM IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES CONTAINED IN SECTIONS 25-1-516 AND 18-1.3-501, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, INCLUDING A FINE OF UP TO FIVE THOUSAND (5,000) DOLLARS AND IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL FOR UP TO EIGHTEEN MONTHS.
